



ACE Mentor Program of Greater NY

The ACE Mentor Program of Greater NY is a free after-school mentorship program to introduce high school students to careers in architecture, engineering, and construction management.

Students are organized on teams set-up to emulate actual design teams. Industry professionals are mentors that guide the students through a mock design project while introducing them to the careers, industry vocabulary, and various roles companies play in the industry.

Teams meet for at least 15 sessions, for two hours after school over the course of the academic year. Sessions include hands-on activities, use of design software, office tours, and field trips to construction/project sites.

At the end of the season, teams come together to present their mock design project to peers, mentors, and industry leaders.
