



ACE Mentor Program of Greater NY

The ACE Mentor Program of Greater NY is a **free** after-school mentorship program that introduces high school students to careers in architecture, engineering, and construction management.

Students are organized on teams set-up to emulate actual design teams. Industry professionals are mentors that guide the students through a **mock design project** while introducing them to the careers, industry vocabulary, and various roles companies play in the industry.

During team meetings, students will learn about **core principles of the industry**, use **design software**, gain **communication** and **technical skills**, and go on virtual **construction site tours!** ACE GNY will also hold **webinars** on applying for scholarships, essay writing, networking, and college prep.

ACE GNY is designed for everyone - students with and without prior knowledge of the design and construction industry.
