

Acceptable Majors for Scholarship Awards

Approved by the Board of Directors on January 12, 2010

The intent of the scholarship program is to provide financial assistance to students who are in a course of study that generally leads to a career in the design and construction industry. The following majors are acceptable for purposes of being awarded a scholarship and for receiving an annual disbursement:

Architecture
Interior Design
Landscape Architecture
Architectural Engineering

Civil Engineering
Electrical Engineering
Mechanical Engineering
Environmental Engineering
Urban and Regional Planning

Construction Management

Computer Science

Other majors may be acceptable, at the discretion of the Education Committee.

If a student is considering a major not listed above and would still like to be considered for a scholarship, the student must include, together with his or her scholarship application, a persuasive explanation of how the major will lead to a career in the design and construction industry. Likewise, students who are submitting a disbursement form and who are not enrolled in a major listed above must submit a similar explanation with their disbursement form.

This policy applies for all scholarships awarded in 2007 and subsequent years.
